### WHAT IS GOD'S GRACE?

#### 1. God's Grace is A Gift to me

Romans 11:6 (NL T2): *"And since it is through God's kindness, then it is not by their good works. For in that case, God's grace would not be what it really is-free and undeserved."*

Romans 3:23-24 (NKJV): *"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,"*

#### 2. God's Grace is Receive by Faith

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NKJV): *"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast."*

John 6:44 (NKJV): *"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. "*
