WHEN YOU’RE WATING FOR DELIVERANCE

1. Remember WHAT GOD CAN DO.

Romans 4:17 (NCV): *“As it is written in the Scriptures: “I am making you a father of many nations.” This is true before God, the God Abraham believed, the God who gives life to the dead and who creates something out of nothing.”*

Luke 18:27 (NIV): *Jesus said "What is impossible with men is possible with God."*

2. Rely ON WHAT GOD HAS SAID.

Romans 4:18a (MSG): *“When everything was hopeless, Abraham believed anyway, deciding to live not on the basis of what he saw he couldn't do but on what God said he would do.”*

Hebrews 11:17 (TLB): *“While God was testing him, Abraham still trusted in God and his promises, and so he offered up his son Isaac and was ready to slay him on the altar of sacrifice;”*

Romans 4:18 (NIV): *“Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, "So shall your offspring be.”*

3. Face THE FACTS WITH FAITH.

Romans 4:19-21 (MSG): *“Abraham didn't focus on his own impotence and say, "It's hopeless. This hundred-year-old body could never father a child." Nor did he survey Sarah's decades of infertility and give up. He didn't tiptoe around God's promise asking cautiously skeptical questions. He plunged into the promise and came up strong, ready for God, sure that God would make good on what he had said.”*

2 Corinthians 4:18 (NIV): *“So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.”*

4. Expect GOD TO DELIVER YOU.

Romans 4:20-21 (TLB): *“But Abraham never doubted. He believed God, for his faith and trust grew ever stronger, and he praised God for this blessing even before it happened. He was completely sure that God was well able to do anything he promised.”*

2 Corinthians 1:9-10 (NIV): *“Indeed, in our hearts we felt the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead. He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us,”*

- 3. The ultimate deliverance IS HEAVEN.**
