2 Chronicles 16:9a (MSG): *“GOD is always on the alert, constantly on the lookout for people who are totally committed to him...”*

**FIVE COMMITMENTS
THAT WILL CHANGE MY LIFE AND MY WORLD**

1. I must commit MY LIFE TO JESUS CHRIST.

Romans 10:9 (NIV): *“That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”*

2. I must commit to being A MEMBER OF GOD’S FAMILY.

1 Peter 1:3 (TLB): *“All honor to God, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ; for it is his boundless mercy that has given us the privilege of being born again so that we are now members of God’s own family. Now we live in the hope of eternal life because Christ rose again from the dead.”*

Romans 12:10 (NIV): *“Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.”*

3. I must commit to being AN EXAMPLE OF JESUS CHRIST.

Hebrews 6:1a, b (TLB): *“Let us stop going over the same old ground again and again, always teaching those first lessons about Christ. Let us go on instead to other things and become mature in our understanding, as strong Christians ought to be...”*

4. I must commit to being AN AGENT OF HIS GRACE.

1 Peter 4:10 (NIV): *“Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.”*

5. I commit to being A MESSENGER OF HIS LOVE.

2 Corinthians 5:19-20 (NIV): *“that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.”*

2 Peter 3:15 (TLB): *“And remember why he is waiting. He is giving us time to get his message of salvation out to others. Our wise and beloved brother Paul has talked about these same things in many of his letters.”*
